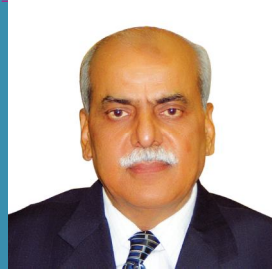


FOREWORD

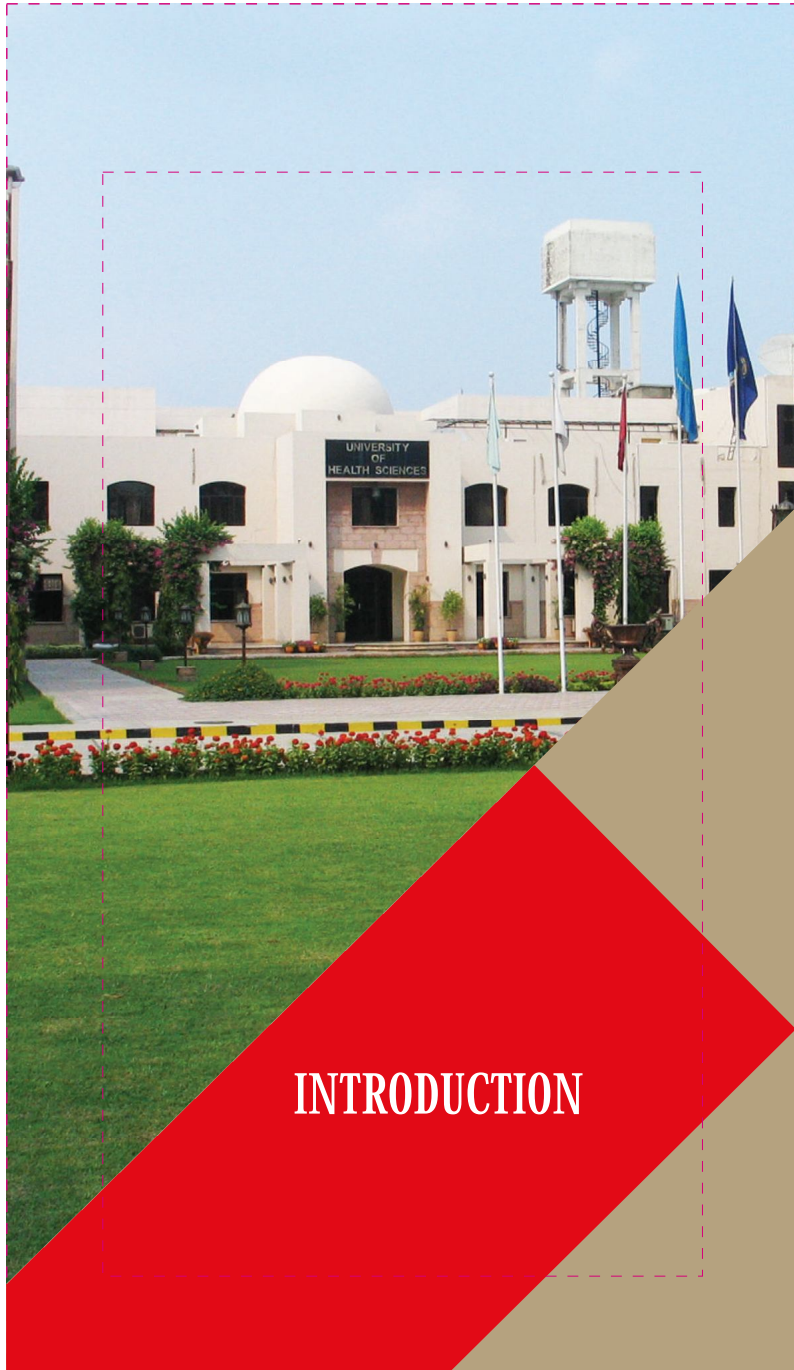

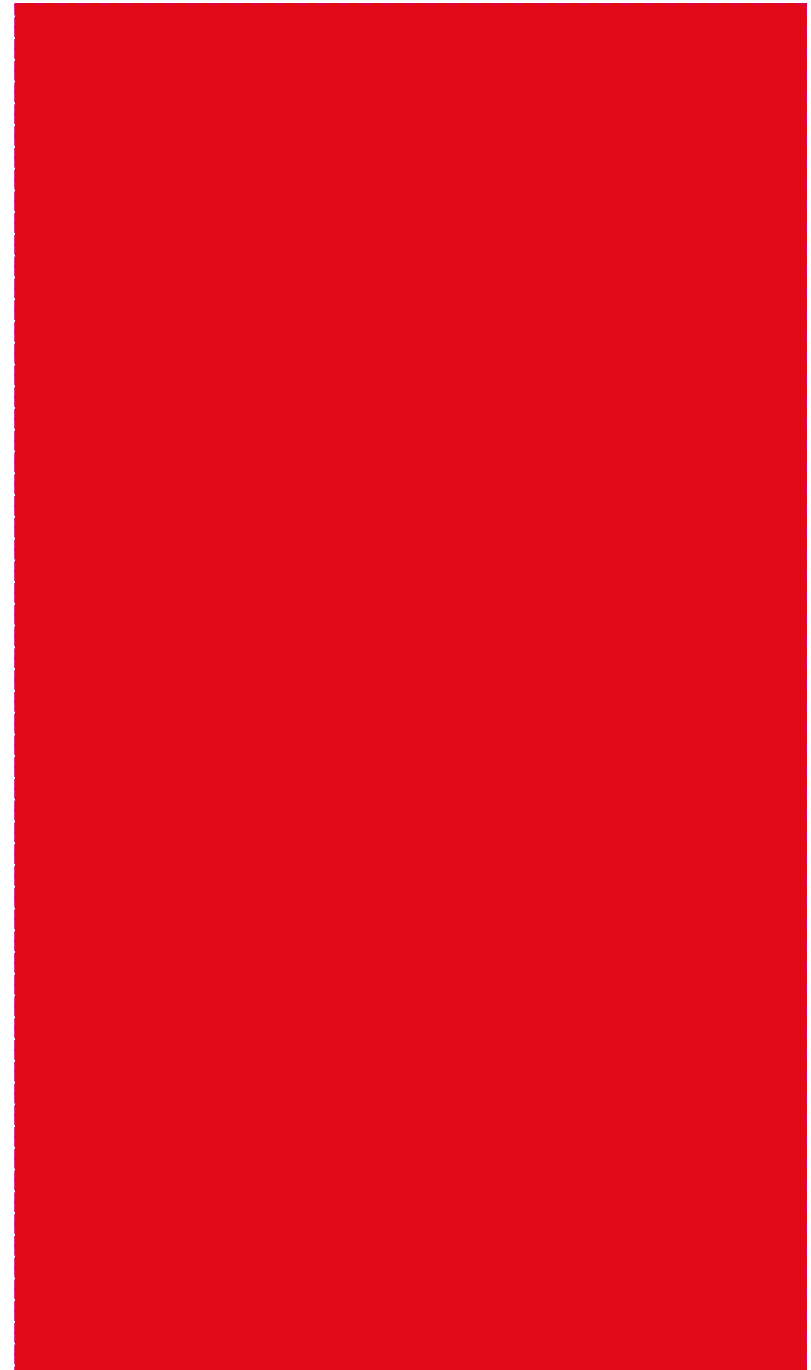

INTRODUCTION

“To train health professionals through Bio-Psycho-Social Model and develop human resources required for meaningful, multidisciplinary health care”.

OUR MISSION

“To bring a qualitative and quantitative revolution in medical education by providing an environment geared towards promoting research and academic culture in order to improve the existing healthcare system”.





Established in 2002, the University of Health Sciences Lahore, most often referred to by its acronym 'UHS', is the largest health sciences educational institution in Pakistan with over 60000 registered students and 70+ affiliated institutions. Together, the five faculties offer around 100 programmes of study in medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, allied health sciences and nursing.

The university regulates and coordinates the activities of medical education, training & research in healthcare throughout the province of Punjab. It is also the provincial authority which conducts Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) every year for admission to all public and private sector medical and dental colleges of the province.

University has been placed at No.2 in Higher Education Commission of Pakistan's National University Ranking for 2012 and 2013 consecutively in the field of medical and health sciences and at No.8 among all universities and higher education institutions of Pakistan. With regards to quality assurance procedures, the University has been placed in top "W" category by HEC in 2014.

The motivational force of the University's research activities is financially and politically independent, i.e. free basic research; however, specific collaborative endeavours with other institutions, national as well as international, also have a place

among the countless research activities. The University is mainly focusing on higher research degree programmes in Basic Medical Sciences, Allied Health Sciences and Nursing.

UHS is research-intensive. Its ethos from its beginning has been to produce highly relevant research that solves real health problems and improve people's quality of life. At present extensive on-campus research is going on in different areas including diseases such as Asthma, Diabetes, Tuberculosis, Typhoid, Infertility, Environmental Pollution, various types of Cancer, Genetic Disorders, Consanguinity, DNA Analysis, Developmental Abnormalities, Metabolic Syndromes, Hepatitis B & C, Liver and Renal Disorders. A high-tech Resource Lab and an Experimental Research Lab (Animal House) have been established for research purposes.

Internationalization is an essential element for the future development of UHS. For the University, internationalization means providing students with opportunities for gaining international experience and for developing the skills to function effectively in the world. Within a short time of its formation, the University has developed collaboration with several International Institutes. Prominent among them are Duke University, University of Texas Houston, University of Pittsburgh, Center of Disease Control (CDC) Atlanta, University of Liverpool, University of Glasgow, University of Nottingham, University of Reim France and University of Muenster Germany.

University of Health Sciences is now much more than a health sciences' institution: It is a place that prepares students for success in an increasingly complex and interconnected global society.

GOVERNANCE



Legal Status:

The University was established by the University of Health Sciences Lahore Ordinance, 2002 (LVIII of 2002). It's a public sector university recognized by the Higher Education Commission of Pakistan, Pakistan Medical and Dental Council, and included in the Directory of the World Health Organization.

Jurisdiction:

The University exercises its powers conferred on it by or under its Ordinance within the territorial limits of the Province of the Punjab. Its Section 37 reads:

“All medical institutions, whether in public or private sector, located within the geographical boundaries of the Province of the Punjab, whether affiliated with any other university, examination board or a medical faculty, notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force, shall affiliate with the University within such period and on such terms and conditions, as may be prescribed.”

Statutory Role:

The primary role of the university, as



specified in the Ordinance 2002, includes provision of instruction and dissemination of knowledge, advancement of research, prescription of courses of studies, holding of examination, award of degrees, diplomas, certificates and other destinations, establishment of institutes, colleges, centres of learning for the development of teaching and research.

The general supervision and control of the administrative, academic and financial affairs and the powers to lay down the policies of the university is vested in a Board of Governors currently consisting of the following members:

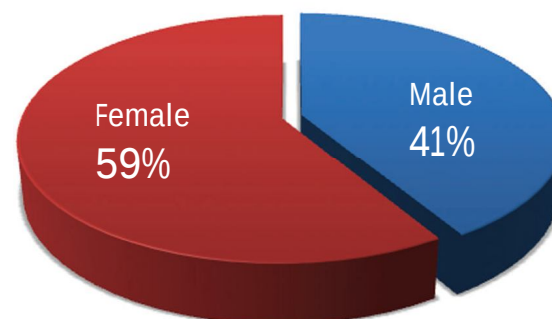
UNIVERSITY ORGANIZATION





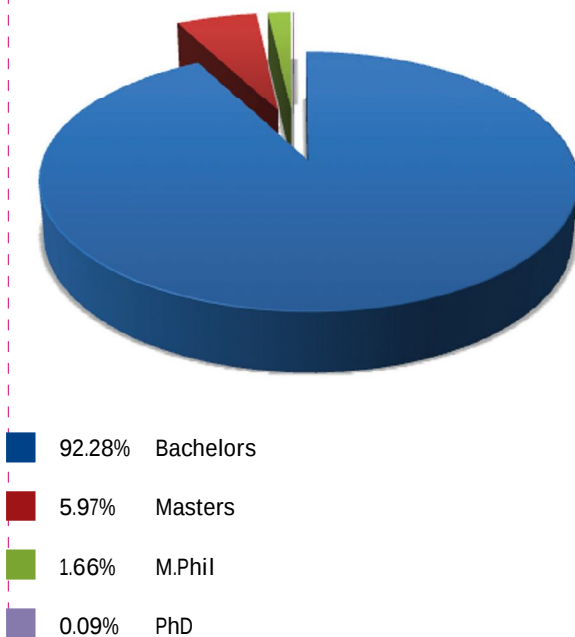
